Présentation du programme – Centre de Développement de Club (CDC)

The **Club Development Center (CDC)** is a program for children **born in 2015/2014 (U11/U12)** who want to improve their soccer skills while still having fun playing.

The program is supervised by young coaches and a coach certified at least at the C License level, ensuring a structured and safe learning environment.

This program is open to everyone, but places are limited in order to comply with the coach/player ratios required by Soccer Quebec.

👉 The registration date is the only criterion for admission.

📅 **From May 18, 2026, until the week of August 31, 2026**

Frequency:

The CDC is offered **once or twice a week** for U11/U12 boy and girl players (born in 2015/2014).

One LRSO match is also offered

Types of sessions

⚽ CDC Session – Club Development Center

Session conducted in the form of workshops with certified coaches.

It includes **four 15-minute workshops** covering the essential aspects of development at this age:

- ✅ **Technical workshop**
- ✅ **Themed match workshop**
- ✅ **Technical-tactical workshop**
- ✅ **Match workshop** (small-sided games)

This session is exactly the same as the normal CDC (see above). However, players are grouped into LRSO match teams. This is why this CDC is reserved for players who take part in LRSO matches.
