Pricing :

Registration fee: \$235*

* This fee covers the entire program for the period from October to March.


Important note: If your child did not participate in **the 2025 summer season**, a **\$70 membership fee will be added to the registration fee**.

Equipments :

To ensure that the games run smoothly, here is what your child will need to wear and bring:

- **Game jersey:** loaned by the organization for the entire winter season.
- **Complete soccer uniform:**
- **Blue** shorts
- **Blue** socks
- Shin guards (mandatory)
- Soccer shoes with or without cleats suitable for synthetic turf.
- Hydration: A water bottle or flask with the child's name on it



 Your child must arrive at the match field at the time indicated on the schedule. Attendance software will be implemented at the beginning of the season.

Conditions :


- The program is open to all children of the specified ages.
- It is subject to the **club's internal regulations** and **refund policy**.
- **Places are limited** based on the capacity of the gyms and the number of instructors available, in order to ensure a **safe environment** and **optimal coaching quality**, in accordance with Soccer Canada's recommendations.

Registration will be available online via our website by credit card starting Monday, August 11, 2025, subject to availability.**

When registering online, follow these steps to include **CDSO games**:

1. **Choose a program** that corresponds to your child's age group (with or without practice).
2. Once you have made your selection, you will have access to the **OTHER FEES** section.
3. In this section, **you can add CDSO games** to your registration.
